

# SAME DIFFERENCE

How well do you know your friends or family? Do you know how they think? Do you work well as a team? Same Difference will put that to the test. Spin the spinner and determine the nature of the round, then select a card from the pile and let the fun begin.

## 3+ PLAYERS - GROUP PLAY

Each round, spin the spinner and determine the nature of the round. The youngest player then grabs a card at random, making sure to cover up the back of the card (as the answers are on the back!). The player with the card must read the card aloud. Next round the player to the left will read the card. Below are the different game modes and how to play:

**SAME:** Without discussing, the players must give an answer each on the count of 3. 1 point is awarded to each player that matches with another player. If the players match but the answer isn't in the Top 5 no points are awarded.

**DIFFERENT:** Without discussing, the players must give an answer each on the count of 3. 1 point is awarded to each player that doesn't match another. If the players answers are different but aren't the Top 5 no points are awarded.

**TOP 3:** The person to the left guesses one answer to the question. Only answers in the Top 3 are correct for this round. The person to their left offers another different answer to the previous, and so on until an incorrect answer is given or 3 answers have been given. The person reading the question will be skipped and must check that the answers given are correct. A point is awarded for each correct answer and a bonus point is awarded if they are given in the correct order.

**TOP 5:** The person to the left guesses one answer to the question. Only answers in the Top 5 are correct for this round.

The person to their left offers another different answer to the previous, and so on until an incorrect answer is given or 5 answers have been given. The person reading the question will be skipped and must check that the answers given are correct. A point is awarded for each correct answer and a bonus point is awarded if they are given in the correct order.

**TOP 1:** Without discussing the players must give one answer each on the count of 3. A point is awarded for each correct answer.

The player with the most points after 15 rounds is the winner!

## 6+ PLAYERS - TEAM HEAD TO HEAD PLAY

Divide your group into 2 teams. Each round, taking turns, one team will spin the spinner and determine the nature of the round. The first team to ask the question then grabs a card at random, making sure to cover up the back of the card. The player with the card must read the card aloud. Next round the roles will reverse. Below are the different game modes and how to play:

**SAME:** Without discussing, the team must give an answer each on the count of 3. 1 point is awarded for each player that matches with another player. If the players match but the answer isn't in the Top 5 no points are awarded.

**DIFFERENT:** Without discussing, the team must give an answer each on the count of 3. 1 point is awarded for each player that doesn't match another. If the players answers are different but

aren't the Top 5 no points are awarded.

**TOP 3:** For this category, the players are allowed to discuss the answers. The team must guess the top 3 answers to the question. A point is awarded for each correct answer, and a bonus point is awarded if they are in the correct order.

**TOP 5:** For this category, the players are allowed to discuss the answers. The team must guess the top 5 answers to the question. A point is awarded for each correct answer, and 2 bonus points are awarded if they are in the correct order.

**TOP 1:** Without discussing, the players must give one answer each on the count of 3. The point is awarded if the majority of the team got the answer correct.

The team with the most points after 20 rounds is the winner!

## 2 PLAYERS – PUT YOUR HEADS TOGETHER!

You and your pair must work together. Each round, if a point is not achieved you lose a life. When you win, place that card in a pile and when you lose, place that card at the bottom of the pile of cards. You have 3 lives. When you lose all your lives, count your win card pile and try to set a new record!

**EXTRA LIFE:** An extra life can be achieved if a Top 1 answer is successfully given.
